ORDINANCE NO. 1982-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALBANY, COUNTY OF BERKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1978-4 BY REQUIRING THE CUTTING OF WEEDS IN NON-RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF THE TOWNSHIP ON OR BEFORE THE FIFTEENTH DAY OF JUNE AND THE FIRST DAY OF AUGUST OF EACH YEAR AND WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS OF THE APPEARANCE GENERALLY OF WEED FLOWERS ON SUCH NON-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Albany, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1978-4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Non-residential areas

Any person, not living in a residential area, within the Township shall cut any and/or all noxious weeds on or before the fifteenth day of June and the first day of August of each year and, in addition thereto, shall cut such noxious weeds within ten (10) days of the appearance generally of weed flowers on such non-residential property; provided that this section shall apply only to land with slope of less than fifteen percent (15%) and provided further, that this section shall not apply to lands which are too wet to permit access by mowing machines during the time of said wetness.

SECTION 2. Severability

Should any article, section, sub-section, paragraph, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. Repealer

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, in so far, but only in so far, as the same are inconsistent herewith.
